To qualify for a scholarship, you must submit a completed application packet to include the following:

- 1. A completed Application Form and Check-List.
- 2. A written response to all essay questions on application form.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript, which verifies a <u>2.5 grade point average or</u> higher.
- 4. A resume that highlights your extracurricular activities at school, in your community and/or church.
- 5. Two (2) letters of reference (one (1) academic and one (1) may be non-academic).

All applications must be postmarked or delivered by **April 30, 2017**.

The National Association of Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club of Michigan was formed in Detroit in 2004 and serves as the Mother Chapter (first chapter established) for Michigan. The NABSMC is a nonprofit 501(c)3 organization and an affiliate of the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club (NABSTMC). There are currently over 120 NABSTMC chapters throughout the United States and abroad with 3 chapters in Michigan including Detroit, Flint and Grand Rapids.

- **B.** Essay 2: Write a 500 word essay (2-3 paragraphs) that clearly explains extenuating circumstances the Committee should consider that may have caused a financial stress to your family; factors such as deaths, major illness, extended period of unemployment of parents or guardians, etc. Explain why this scholarship is necessary to help fund your college education.
- **C.** Essay 3: Write a 250 word essay (1-2 paragraphs) demonstrating what you know about the history of the original Buffalo Soldiers and their contributions to American history.

PART III. ATTACHMENTS

- **D.** Attach a **RESUME** that highlights your extracurricular activities in your school, community, and/or church. Indicate any volunteer activities and any leadership positions you may have had, i.e. president, chairperson, etc.
- E. Attach two (2) LETTERS OF REFERENCE (one (1) academic and (1) may be non-academic).
- F. Attach an official current high school TRANSCRIPT.

PLEASE NOTE

Consideration will be given only to candidates submitting <u>complete</u> application packets including signed Check-List. If selected, the award will be submitted to the educational institution of the student's choice for use towards school costs and expenses. Awards will be made only upon presentation of proof of enrollment at an accredited community college or four-year college or university. **Awards will be made on a one-time basis**.
