These high-stake tests are important and provide pertinent information about a student's academic progress and give a snapshot of their current academic levels in Math, ELA and Science. We are preparing for an exciting summer school program. Your child may have received an invite to our All-Star Summer Success Program! We are looking forward to working with your child on enriching both Math and ELA skills to help them successfully navigate school in the fall. This summer we hope to use field trips, guest speakers, cooking, projects, and other fun activities to promote learning.

The All-Star Summer Success Program will be housed in the high school this year. The program runs for five weeks, Monday-Thursday, starting June 19th through July 20th. We will meet from 8 a.m. - 12 p.mThis . each day. There will not be school on Monday, July 3rd or Tuesday, July 4th. Breakfast and lunch will be provided daily. Bussing is also provided to and from school for in-district students. A separate email communication will be sent from the transportation department with pick-up and drop-off times and locations. The program lasts for only a short period of time so it is imperative that students attend regularly. Students received an invitation for two reasons: to improve and strengthen their ability in Math and ELA, while others are **required** to attend in order to

be promoted to the next grade. *We really do not want to retain any student but for those individuals that did not make the necessary gains to be promoted, we are going to retain them.* Every student under this category has been notified by our Summer School Coordinator through recommendations from their core academic teachers. It is absolutely imperative that you students take advantage of this wonderful academic opportunity as well as all the fun that will take place this summer.
