Nurse Sue's Health Tips

We are entering into pneumonia weather! Take precautions to prevent getting pneumonia. The easiest way to get it is to lead a sedentary life-style. To avoid this life-threatening lung condition:

- 1. Check with your physician regarding the pneumonia shot.
- 2. Keep moving, if possible, move your hands and legs if unable to stand.
- 3. Sleep with the head of the bed elevated, if needed have someone place bricks under the head of the bed and sleep on 2 pillows. Avoid lying flat in bed.
- 4. Take in 3 deep breaths & blow out the first two, on the exhale of the 3rd breath cough instead of blowing the breath out. This process loosens the (phlegm) secretions in the throat and lungs. Do this 2-3 times every hour & drink lots of fluids.

Symptoms of Pneumonia:

- 1. Shortness of breath at rest & with activity.
- 2. Low grade fever.
- 3. Fatigue
- 4. Coughing up bloody or dark colored phlegm.

If you have these symptoms, you need to see your doctor for treatment.
